



Sayfglida Lifeline System

As an option on Seatrax cranes, a safety glide system can be installed to provide additional safety to technicians working on the boom. Provided by SALA, the Sayfglida Engineered Permanent Horizontal Lifeline System is used as a personal fall arrest or restraint system. This system offers handsfree and constant protection as the linked individual moves horizontally along the boom.

To utilize this system, the operator must first feed the detachable Sayfink Sleeve onto the system by depressing locking pins on the sleeve. While depressing the locking pins, swing the sleeve's gate open and capture the cable by closing the gate around cable. Using Figure 1, the operator can determine if the sleeve will be fed onto the cable with this label right side up or upside down. The technician can now attach the provided shock absorbing lanyard or self-retracting lifeline. This is attached to a full body harness at the back d-ring.

Once attached, the sleeve will follow the user along the lifeline and pass over support brackets installed along the line.
